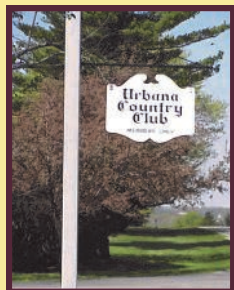

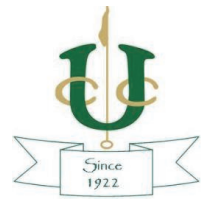

Dye golf course legacy begins in Urbana



The Urbana Country Club has an intriguing history as unique as its rolling, eighteen hole golf course. It has been host to many of golf's legendary heroes: Gene Sarazan, Tommy

County farmland into the Urbana Country Club in 1922; thus starting a legacy of golf course designs that is famous the world over

In 1991, the land adjacent to the Club was purchased with plans of building an additional nine holes at a future date. It was at this time that Mrs. Elizabeth Dye (wife of the original designer) asked her grandson P.B. Dye if he would go to Urbana and finish the job his

began. The fairways were seeded by the fall of 1992 and a dedication ceremony was held August 27, 1993.

The Urbana Country Club is one of the finest courses in Ohio and is unique among the many world famous Dye designed layouts. The original nine holes offers a

challenge with its rolling fairways and small, well bunkered, undulating greens. The new nine offers all golfers a more contemporary Dye design.

Complimenting each other, these two nine hole courses provide a unique golfing experience.

After convincing Scott Seed Company in Marysville to experiment with bent grass, Urbana Country Club was the

Dining at the Urbana Country Club is truly a "best kept secret" in Champaign County and is among the best dining facilities in the area.

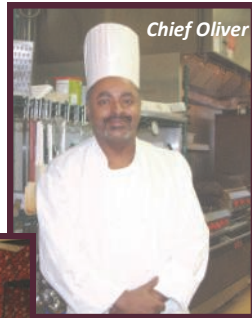
The Club boasts several dining options. The traditional **Grill Room** offers the finest in luncheon selections as well as casual dinner dining.
